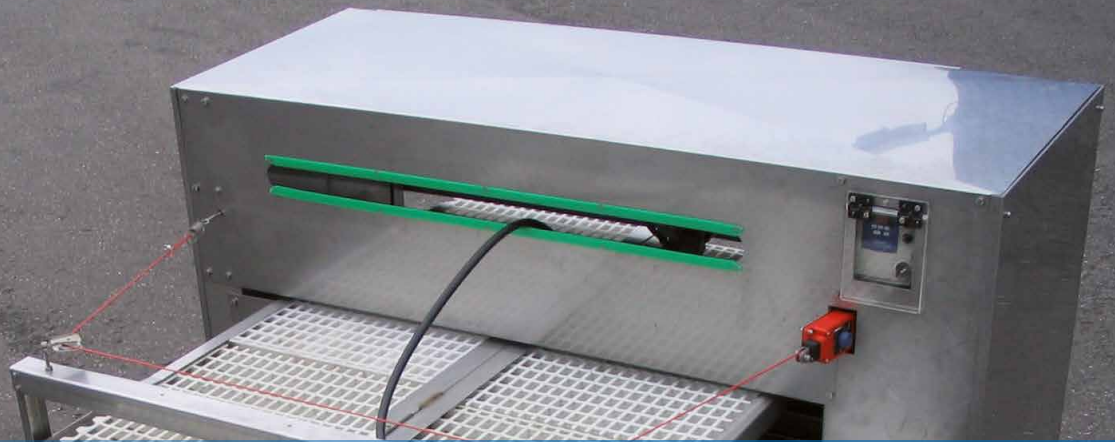




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Slat Washer



**Cleans slats quickly
and efficiently**

Benefits

The slat cleaner offers the following advantages:

- ✓ Slats are being uniformly cleaned
- ✓ Slat washer cleans 2 to 5 slats per minute
- ✓ Slats can be cleaned with cold water
- ✓ Slat washer can also be set up for cleaning wooden slats
- ✓ Assembly is not necessary as the slat washer is delivered ready to use
- ✓ The slat washer is maintenance free as it is made from stainless steel
- ✓ Easy to use and time saving

About the slat washer

Manual slat cleaning is no longer necessary because the Jansen slat washer cleans the slats. Wooden as well as plastic slats can be cleaned with the slat washer.

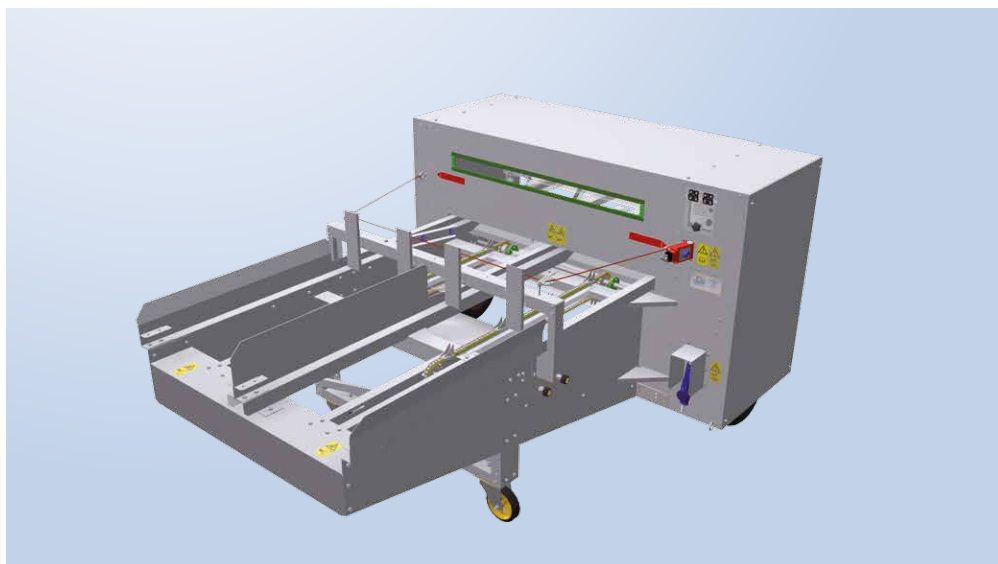
2-5 slats per minute

After the slats have been soaked, stack 10 – 15 plastic slats in the slat denester. The chain mechanism of the slat washer takes the bottom slat and moves it through the slat washer. High pressure spray nozzles thoroughly clean the slats on the top and bottom. The slats are being cleaned with cold water at high pressure (150 bar with plastic slats). The slat washer cleans 2 – 5 slats per minute depending on the degree of dirt, soaking time and slat type.

Technische details

Options

The slat washer can be outfitted with:

- Two U-channels which makes it possible to move the slat washer with a fork lift
- Extra high pressure cleaning capability



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
